## Ziad Medoukh Palestine

Palestinian director Soud Mehna made a 6-minute documentary during the olive harvest season in Gaza during the month of November 2021. Inspired by the poem, (The olive trees still grow in Gaza) composed by the French-speaking writer and poet Ziad Medoukh, and masterfully phrased by the voice of Rwan Shawa, a French-speaking graduate of the University of Gaza, assisted by the scenario of the French-speaking team "Gaza la vie". (Olives are still growing in Gaza), is the first French-language film on the picking of olives shot in Palestine, it presents the major dimension brought to us during this season within Palestinian society, which participates massively in this event. national, from generation to generation, despite the Israeli blockade imposed for almost 14 years.

This film is a powerful message that manifests an enduring love of Palestinians rooted deeply in their ancestral land just like their olive trees in the land of Palestine. This testimony is the expression of peaceful resistance, for a future life full of hope for themselves, their children and future generations, as life continues in this isolated Palestinian enclave.

The directors and producers, all assisted by the team of (Gaza la vie) and all the young francophone of the Gaza Strip, confirm through the documentary film that Gaza retains the hope of a better life and that the Palestine continues to cling to life. Ziad Medoukh warmly expresses his gratitude to the photographer, Mohamed Madhoun, the production company IPM, the Khozndar family, and the young Francophone of Gaza for their efforts and participation in the release of this remarkable film, he hopes that the documentary will be shown in theaters in French-speaking countries.

## **Arnaldo Marques de Azevedo J Brazil**

### **Artist**

Honored to receive this important tribute from the Circle of Peace Ambassadors. It took me a long time to respond because these days I have been thinking about how to thank and also make myself available in the search for better paths to the long awaited peace. In November 2017, my 32-year-old son was murdered in front of me here in São Paulo, and the reason for this brutal and unjust death was that we denounced a crime of abuse of incompetents.

The alleged perpetrator promised revenge and after a little over a year my son was murdered by people who had connections to the alleged mastermind. Our life was no longer easy but after this tragedy the struggles intensified. My son was 32 years old and he left a little girl who is now 9 years old. In 2018 I had the idea of setting up a social project that would address this issue of violence, but from the victim's point of view, I then set up the PROAMA Project - Adalton Marques de Azevedo Project (name of my son), whose objective is to support victims of violence and their families. In 2019, we had the opportunity to help elementary school children at a municipal school here in Osasco, providing them with psychological and educational assistance. This was possible because I succeeded in obtaining a room with an association to provide these services. Two months ago, I learned that this room would no longer be available from January 2022. It is very sad to see that there are so many obstacles to doing good. We are living in an unprecedented global crisis and we understand that everyone is going through difficult times of adaptation and adaptation, but we also know that the demand for help has sometimes multiplied and we find ourselves among so many families and children in need of help or even a moment of orientation, but we feel our hands are tied for lack of resources and supports. In the midst of it all, we received this tribute from you. Thank you very much, I really hope that you will manage to bring the longed-for peace that we long for.

May God enlighten your work and draw others with your courage and determination to this important mission.

This picture to the left here was designed in 1985 by Germain Dufour, and represented at the time the vision of the world in 2024. The picture was all made of symbols. At the back is "the wall" where a group of people are making sure those coming in have been properly check out before being let in. Many of the requirements for being let in have already been defined and described over time in many of the monthly Newsletters published by Global Civilization. In the middle is a couple with a child actually going through the screening process. At the front people from all over the world are waiting to be checked in as global citizens. The two star like objects that seem to be flying above the people are actually drone-like objects keeping peace and security.

## **STATEMENT OF THE OBJECT**

1. Awaken an awareness of spiritual values in everyday life.
2. Promote planetary consciousness, which leads to planetary citizenship. This includes an awareness of the underlying energetic structure of our society, the realms of nature, the planet, and the solar system.
3. Analyze and help solve the world's problems on the basis of spiritual values and planetary consciousness, thus responding to the real needs of today.

## **AREAS OF SERVICE**

1. Cooperation with other educational institutions to create a university of planetary synthesis. The main areas of work of the University of Planetary Synthesis are:
  - a) The application of spiritual values such as love of truth, personal responsibility, sense of justice (which leads to true love), constructive cooperation, selfless service to the great whole;
  - b) The seven departments of human science: politics, religion, education, science, philosophy, psychology, culture and the arts; c) Practical training of the world's servers in ten service areas: education, politics, religion, science, psychology, economics (including finance), telepathic communication, trained observation, magnetic healing and creativity. These are the so-called ten seed groups.
2. Transnational networking with people active in the service areas mentioned above and forming triangles of individuals and groups with similar goals. The IPS is therefore a global organism of the living group. IPS is listed by the United Nations Economic and Social Council.

## **ACTIVITIES**

1. Organization of meetings, seminars, conferences, workshops, group meditations.
2. Advice for people in key positions in groups and organizations in areas such as international politics, health, education, world religion, economics, the arts.
3. Compilation and distribution of studies from the books of Master Djwhal Khul, Alice A. Bailey, HP Blavatsky, Agni Yoga Society, Dr. E. Krishnamacharya and others on topics related to the above mentioned fields and on the ten seed groups. These studies are available in English, French, German, Portuguese, Russian and Spanish.
4. Publication of a website in English, French, German, Portuguese, Russian and Spanish with reports on IPS activities in cooperation with other groups around the world.
5. Creation of a documentation center in Geneva, with information on the group's activities in the ten service areas mentioned above. The center is open to everyone.
