Here, the prize would be the "Silver Pegasus Pen", whose image adorns the roof of the Poznań Opera House. He is aware that I cannot afford to fund an appropriate prize, which is why these will probably be Diplomas with the image of the title prizes (the image of an Angel and Pegasus), the only hope to give it an appropriate rank is the Patronage of the President over this event. The third and final stage of this event is the participation of students or students of music schools, who will compose a song to the poetry of their choice from the second stage. The prize for them should be a title

Youth Ambassador of Peace. In my opinion, the whole thing should end with a concert combined with an opening of competition works. Currently, I have informed the Board of Education in Poznań about my intention. There is a preliminary approval of my idea and the reward on the part of the Board of Trustees is adding important points to the school grades sheet of the winners of each stage. If it is feasible, I will start developing the Rules of the Competition.

So I am asking President Simond to support my promotional activities related to World Peace in my original project.

Despite an explosive situation in the Gaza Strip, with the Israeli bombing of this blockaded region this week, determined young people continue their activities and actions for children and students from different structures and centers all over the Gaza Strip.

For the start of this year 2021, and in order to reassure the children of this locked up region, on Thursday, January 21, 2021, four young people organized an animation and psychological support session for the dozens of children in Gaza City.

This activity is part of the sixth part of the psychological support program for children in the Gaza Strip, started in September 2014. Its objective was to approach children to make them forget the horrors of the last military offensive Israel, and various Israeli aggressions against the Gaza Strip. The activity, which lasted two hours, took place in the Nawal center in the east of the city, as part of their winter camp. The 25 participants were very attentive and very interested.

They greatly appreciated this activity. They showed joy and an excellent welcome. The team formed in September 2014, and which runs various reception centers in the Gaza Strip, offered them several activities. During this session offered by these young people, children, boys and girls alike had a great time, with moments of happiness and laughter mixed with warm applause. Seeds of Peace Switzerland

Graines de Paix is an innovative international NGO, leader in the field of full quality education. This is based on the UN definition of quality education (SDG 4) to which are added: - the full development of children and well-being in the classroom (SDG 3) - gender equity (SDG 5) - prevention of violence and radicalization (SDG 16) - strengthening societal cohesion and peace (SDG 16). To achieve these goals,

Graines de Paix provides educational resources and regularly approved national training. It is thus recognized and invited to intervene by Swiss authorities and ministries of developing countries. The same goes for its complementary work with communities.

Founded in Geneva in 2005 as an association, Graines de Paix became a Swiss Foundation at the end of 2020. It is independent of any religious, sectarian or political obedience, while being actively open to dialogue and exchange.

It is active in Switzerland, France and West Africa. Its work is supported by UNICEF, SDC, the city of Geneva, foundations and private donors. It has also signed with Tunisia, Lebanon and Senegal and these agreements also deserve to be financed.

In 2019, she received the Smart peace Prize from the Leaders for Peace Foundation for her educational approach including the prevention of violence. Its jury was impressed by the very positive opinion of the education authorities interviewed. Seeds of Peace's educational approach to preventing violence in schools were recognized by the UN Girls' Education Initiative in December 2020.

President World Citizens

The United Nations General Assembly on 20 October 2010 proclaimed the first week of February of each year as the “World Interfaith Harmony Week” among all religions, faiths and beliefs. The General Assembly resolution recognized “the imperative need for dialogue among the different faiths and religions in enhancing mutual understanding, harmony and cooperation among people.” The week has a potential to promote the healing of religion-based tensions in the world.

Thus, the Association of World Citizens welcomes this effort to develop respect and mutuality among diverse cultures and religions. Today, there is a broad and deep movement toward openness and goodwill among religious and spiritual communities. New awareness of shared ethical principles opens the way for creative engagement.

There is a need for cooperative action to bring the wisdom of religious traditions to meet the economic, environmental and social challenges that humanity faces. The ecological crisis has a spiritual dimension. We must help humanity to develop a reverence for all life and respect for the sacredness of the Earth, our common home.

A Voice for Our Time in finding harmony is that of Chou Tun-yi (1017-1073) known as the Master of Lien-hsi. During the Sung dynasty (960-1279), after a period of division and confusion, there was a conscious effort to bring together into harmonious framework currents of thought that existed in China but often as separate and sometimes hostile schools of thought: Confucianism, Buddhism, philosophical Taoism, and religious Taoism. These efforts were called Tao hsueh –the study of Tao.

Chou Tun-yi was a leading figure in this effort. He developed a philosophy based on the harmony of Yin and Yang, a harmony known through intuition as each person has within himself the capacity to know what is right. This capacity of intuition, what Chou Tun-yi called “straightforwardness in movement”, properly developed, will lead to impartiality and universality, the Confucian ideal of Sagehood. (1)

Today, the currents of thought linked to Christianity and Islam needed to be added to the currents of Confucianism, Buddhism and Taoism. However, the need to develop the capacity of properly using intuition remains a vital approach – a goal for Harmony Week.
