His journey embodies the power of youth-led change. In a candid conversation from his home in Morocco, the founder of Youth for Peace and Dialogue between Cultures shares his story with Young and Diplomatic, revealing how his personal experiences have shaped his mission to transform society. He grew up during Morocco's "Years of Lead," a dark period marked by state oppression and forced disappearances. These experiences, combined with his father's work in human rights, inspired him to take action.

He is also an entrepreneur and a law graduate. Since launching his organization in 2005, El Hamel's initiatives have attracted worldwide attention, receiving recognition from the juries of the Nobel Alternative Prize and the Public Peace Prize.

El Hamel opens up about his daily work with Moroccan youth, his advocacy strategies for human rights in North Africa, and his peace project. Through practical examples and lived wisdom, he paints a vivid picture of Morocco's social evolution while illuminating the path for future change makers.

As I grew up and witnessed these injustices, I began to seriously consider becoming a peace and human rights advocate to make human rights a reality in Morocco.

The Graines d'Avenir association was created on January 5, 2005, co-founded by Veronique Jannot, President, Odile Foubert, Secretary General and Philippe Poiret, Vice-President: "Having had the chance to meet Tibetan culture, to rub shoulders with it, to discover it and to appreciate its values, it seemed obvious to us to create this association in order to support it." Jetsun Pema (Sister of the Dalai Lama, President of the Tibetan Children's Village) was pleased to accept the honorary presidency of Graines d'Avenir.

Graines d'Avenir sets up sponsorships for monks and lay people (children, adolescents and adults), as well as elderly people, in India and Nepal. They are mainly Tibetan refugees and of Tibetan culture. They are most often cut off from their roots and the affection of their loved ones and do not know when they will see them again, or if they will see them again ... Some live with their family, sometimes with only one parent or in foster families, their living conditions are always very precarious. Still others, often coming from extremely poor families, only have access to education by integrating monasteries.

I have been working in a library for six months. However, I continue to work for peace in my state of Pernambuco. After the sixth embrace of peace in Igarassu in 2024, I realized that I had to develop activities in my state of Pernambuco, which is unfortunately very violent. I am implementing an action called "Action "Pernambuco Peace Days" that will last two years and that started on 9/21/2024 and will last until 9/21/2026.

I sent an open letter to the presidents of the 184 municipal councils of Pernambuco. In the research I did on the official pages of these assemblies, I discovered that only 13 municipalities have created a municipal day of peace by law, Igarassu being the first of them. So, 171 do not have a Peace Day. After sending it three times, I received responses from 47 city councils and one of them has already created a Peace Day by law and is just waiting for the mayor to sign.

In the first half of 2025, I will work with those who responded to raise awareness of the importance of Peace Day. And there will be 46 cities per semester. It is a slow process, but we are moving towards peace. With the approval of the law in the city of Araçoiaba, I will have more strength to give to the city. This action began on the International Day of Peace, September 21, 2024, and from August to November of this year, we were in the period of municipal elections in Brazil, and there was a lot of confusion.

But with the adoption of the law in Araçoiaba and with the new classes of legislators, I think it will be easier. When the city of Araçoiaba finalizes the Peace Day law, I will summarize this action and send it to you to be published in our official bulletin.

For now, this is internal information to let you know that your Brazilian ambassador continues to work for peace. .

Holy Land Trust is proud to announce the launch of Voices for Change, a groundbreaking program, funded by the Office of Palestinian Affairs/US Embassy Jerusalem, designed to equip Palestinian youth with the skills and resilience to shape their own futures.

This innovative initiative goes beyond traditional, linear learning models, embracing transformational learning that fosters leadership, nonviolence, and social impact.

At the heart of Voices for Change is the mission to transform trauma into hope by empowering 40 young Palestinian students from universities in Bethlehem Governorate.

Selected participants will undergo a series of intensive training sessions that will enhance their leadership skills, build their confidence, and enable them to become agents of meaningful change in their communities.

The program will also directly benefit 20 trainers by honing their expertise in youth engagement and leadership development through the specialized Train the Trainer program.

Thanks to sponsorships and donors, children who have become young adults, become citizens integrated into Senegalese society thanks to their school, university or professional courses say Alain MILLION. Since May 25, 2019, Alain MILLION, known as Alassane, has been an honorary citizen of the city of M'Bour. In the community centre/ashram area, many women have never had the opportunity to receive an education. Coming from marginalized communities, they lead a difficult life of menial labour, barely managing to maintain a minimum standard of living for themselves and their children.

In addition to this, many struggle alone without a husband or, as is often the case, with the burden of an abusive husband. The Women's Education Programme has contributed significantly to improving women's education by giving them greater self-esteem, confidence and new employment opportunities. In addition, the education is provided in a supportive and safe environment, providing positive motivation, guidance and advice to cope with the many challenges. For the past two years, a qualified volunteer teacher has been giving classes for two to three hours per day. The programme provides its service free of charge to approximately 40 women (aged 20 to 60) each day. The main objectives of the courses are: To provide women with basic literary courses

To develop their confidence and leadership qualities.

To create awareness about their rights and responsibilities.

To provide counseling courses for their various mental and social problems.

To provide courses to improve basic concepts on maintaining their good health.
